To all Terrace Residents and Family Members:

Visitation has been updated as follows based on new guidelines from the DOH:

**Advance scheduling of visits is no longer required.**

- Visitation is available 7 days per week at the following times:  
10am – 8pm
- Visitors will be screened upon entering the building and visitation will be denied if the visitor exhibits any symptoms of COVID-19 or do not pass the screening questions.
- Visitors will only be allowed in the resident room or outside (weather permitting).
- All residents and visitors should wear face covering or masks and physical distance, particularly if either is at increased risk for severe disease or are unvaccinated.
- Current COVID-19 positive residents, residents with COVID-19 signs or symptoms, and residents in a quarantine or observation period are eligible for visits as long as the visitor is aware of the risk of potential exposure to the virus. Appropriate personal protective equipment must be worn.
- Visitors violating our policies will be asked to leave.
- Visitors must maintain physical distance from other residents and Terrace staff and wear face masks when around other residents or healthcare personnel, regardless of vaccination status.
- Compassionate care visits will be allowed at all times.
- No limit to the number of resident's visitors at any given time however social distancing is still required in the space allowed.
- COVID testing is not required to visit in assisted living facilities.
