



### **In-Apartment Visitation- Effective 03/04/2022**

- There are no longer limitations on visitations.
- Visitors will be screened upon entering the building and visitation will be denied if the visitor exhibits any symptoms of COVID-19 or do not pass the screening questions.
- Vaccinated and unvaccinated residents and visitors must wear face covering in the common areas. Unvaccinated visitors must wear face covering and social distance at all times.
- Visitors must maintain physical distance from other residents and staff, regardless of vaccination status.
- Current COVID-19 positive residents, residents with COVID-19 signs or symptoms, and residents in a or observation period are not eligible for visits. Alternative mode of visitation will be available.
- Compassionate care visits will be available to all residents.
- Resident apartment will be disinfected after each visit, as well as hallway handrails, elevator, and any other surface the visitors touched.
- If a resident or staff member tests positive for COVID, visitors will be informed of the risks of visiting. In the event of an outbreak, visitations may be modified, per ECDOH guidelines.
- Residents may visit with family members outside at any time or leave for off site visits.
